Deadlines

Internal deadline: November 13, 2017

Agency deadline: January 8, 2018

Limit: One

Applicant must submit a Letter of intent by the agency deadline

The Brain Research Foundation is inviting eligible U.S. institutions to nominate one (1) faculty member to submit a Letter of Intent for the Fay/Frank Seed Grant Program by January 8, 2018. To be eligible, the PI must be a full-time Assistant or Associate Professor working in neuroscience. The program wishes to support new and innovative research projects that have the potential to become competitive for an NIH grant or other external funding sources.

If interested, submit an internal application (or “pre-proposal”) to the Office of Research Development [here](#) no later than January 8. The required documents for the internal application can be found [here](#). If the Division receives more internal applications than the allowed limits, an ad hoc review and selection process will be held. If an ad hoc review process is not warranted, those researchers that demonstrated interest will be allowed to move forward with submitting a full proposal to the funding agency.
