Session Report for May 2018

The session of FPC-Roswell met on Thursday, April 12, 2018 at 5:15pm at the church.

Rev. Guthrie led a discussion on an article entitled “Confessions: Why Do We ‘Confess’ our Faith?”

Church Management Committee: Lynn Karnes is still waiting to hear from a carpet installer regarding the percentage of waste for the proposed installation. One estimate has been received for skylight repairs. One window in a door on the west side still needs repair. Discussion was held regarding the possibility of replacing the sign on the NE corner with a new sign with LED display. Jim Bloodhart to research what might be available and cost.

Worship Committee: Church Attendance: March 18th – 66; March 25th – 72; April 1st – 101; April 8th - 56. Discussion was held as to where to set microphones for “Joys and Concerns” during worship. Lynn and Rev. Guthrie will discuss further.

Nominating Committee: Discussion was held as to the number of new elders and deacons needed. Betty Young will be the deacons’ representative on the Committee and is working on finding new deacons.

Mission Committee met and had Sarah Lewis from the new Roswell Homeless Coalition speak on the homeless shelters for men and women that have recently opened. Mission Committee will look at ways to offer support to the Coalition.

Fellowship Committee: Easter Sunday Breakfast was held on Sunday, April 1st with good attendance. Will look at hamburger/hotdog cookout in June after worship and reception for the Concert of American Music in late June/early July.

Evangelism Committee: Newspaper ads were run during Holy Week for Easter activities at FPC-Roswell and for the Holy Week Luncheons. Advertising was also done on Facebook.

Christian Education Committee: Rev. Guthrie will conduct another Bible Study beginning after Easter and ending at the end of May, to be held on Wednesday nights.
