- WHEREAS, since 2006, South Carolina has lost 26.8 percent of residential construction jobs, totaling nearly 17,000 jobs that were predominantly self-employed; and
- WHEREAS, 82 percent of companies regularly have positions they are unable to fill with qualified workers and experienced tradesmen, and an estimated 24,000 new construction workers are needed to meet the state's current building needs; and
- WHEREAS, Careers in Construction Month is designed to increase public awareness and appreciation of construction craft professionals and the entire construction workforce.
- NOW, THEREFORE, I, Henry McMaster, Governor of the great State of South Carolina, do hereby proclaim October 2017 as
