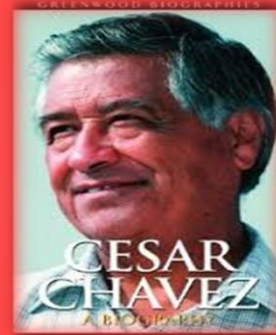

Ricky’s research centers on applied positive psychology, particularly the role psychological strengths, such as hope, play in driving resilience and overall well-being among clients of social service agencies. He has also presented and published in the area of psychometric measurement. Overall, his research takes a community based participatory research paradigm that includes partnership with social services agencies to evaluate their programs in terms of promoting positive psychological strengths among their clients.
