**2<sup>nd</sup> Grade**

- 12 - Elmer's glue sticks
- 1 - pair of Fiskars small safety scissors
- 2 - 4 packs of EXPO brand dry erase markers
- 2 - boxes of Crayola crayons
- 1 - school box
- 1 - backpack (NO WHEELS!)
- 1 - clean, old sock (used to erase dry erase boards)
- 4 - big pink erasers
- 5 - 2-pocket folders, each of them **without** prongs (1 blue, 1 red, 1 green, 1 purple, 1 yellow)

- Girls:

  - 1 box of sandwich-sized Ziploc bags

- 5 - pocket folders (1 of each: red, yellow, blue, green and purple)
- 2 - 1 inch **white** 3-ring binders
- 1 - set of headphones/earbuds to keep at school
- 2 - packages of dividers/tabs for binders
- 1 - package/container of disinfecting wipes
- Last names that begin with...
  - A-M: sandwich-sized Ziploc bags and paper plates
  - N-Z: gallon-sized Ziploc bags and disposable cups

- 3 - packages of regular sized Post-It sticky notes
- 2 - packages of index cards
- 1 - set of headphones/earbuds to keep at school
- 1 - 1-1½ inch 3-ring binder with front cover sleeve (gently used binders may be reused)
- 1 - package of dividers/tabs for binders
- Last names that begin with...
  - A-J: 1 box of sandwich-sized Ziploc bags
