A. Secretary Report (Julie Bates) - April minutes approved
B. Treasurer Report (Wendy Huot) -
a. Dine out money has come in, some from Scholastic, Annual Fund - not deposited yet. $8^{\text {th }}$ grade continuing to spend, not anticipating any left. Guided readers were purchased, normal expenses - Library. Fish fry - Chris to go back and check expenses, VBRDT training funded with Fish Fry dollars
