Dear Community Partner:

We would like to invite you participate in and support the 1st Annual Lights of Love Event in Charlevoix, with all the proceeds benefiting Hospice of Northwest Michigan. This event centers around the 5:15p lighting of the Christmas Tree that will be located down in East Park from December 1 through January 2. After a short dedication and caroling, the community is

then invited to support the restaurants, bars and businesses that have chosen to support the event and to continue the celebration while giving back to Hospice of Northwest Michigan.

We invite the community to sponsor a light or purchase an ornament to decorate the tree in memory or in honor of loved ones for the holiday.
