SUBJECT: PATIENT ACCESS TO CARE IN RURAL AREAS

SUBMITTED BY: MAOPS Legislative Committee

REFERRED TO: Membership for comment

1 WHEREAS, the access to quality healthcare has become a focal point not only in
2 Missouri but nationwide; and

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4 WHEREAS, osteopathic and allopathic physicians are being recruited by hospitals
5 and other large physician groups to locate their practices in populated, urban areas;

8 WHEREAS, 109 of Missouri's 114 counties are rated by the federal government as
9 "below the appropriate provider to patient ratio" and

11 WHEREAS, insurance companies and managed care networks actively decide as to
12 the number of credentialed providers in an area; therefore, be it

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14 RESOLVED, that the Missouri Association of Osteopathic Physicians & Surgeons
15 supports legislation at the state and federal levels that would require all managed care
16 health plans, including Managed Medicaid, to allow a non-network physician to
17 provide services for patients located in a designated Health Professional Shortage
18 Area, should no physician in the necessary specialty be available in the network, and
19 the plans should compensate the physician as if they were an in-network provider at
20 no additional cost to the patient. ~~to have reasonably placed network physicians and~~
21 ~~hospital access in rural areas, and if the distance is unreasonable, the plans should~~
22 ~~pay for out of network services at no additional cost to the patient.~~

Recommendation: The team discussed the resolution at length and determined that an arbitrary distance or time from a provider would not effectively address the issue of access. Instead, they recommend using the pre-defined “Health Professional Shortage Area,” as the criteria. While not perfect, it leaves for interpretation than the original policy, and is less vague than a distance or time requirement.
