ALL SECTION RALLY

21 APR 18

The first meeting was held 11 Jan 18. The following points were discussed and decided.

Location: CFB Edmonton Garrison Field House

Date / Time - Sat 21 Apr 18 0900 – 1500 (depending on the Section)

Cost: Beavers \$6, Cubs / Scouts \$8, Scouters, \$2, Family members partaking in the lunch \$2 each.

Beaver program

Christine Lovell has volunteered to co-ordinate the Beaver program.

The program will be a non-competitive activity consisting of a number of stations. Specific activities have to be finalized.

Cub Program

Tim Lyndon has volunteered to co-ordinate the Cub program.

The Cub Program will consist of two rounds of 15 races. The results of the first series will be used to create four Divisions for the second series of races.

Specific details will be issued later.

Scout Program

We are seeking a volunteer to co-ordinate the Scout program.

The Scout Program will consist of a number of competitive races with participants racing against each other. Specific details will be issued later.

Vehicle Specifications

There are no specific regulations with respect to the construction of the Beaver Buggy other than the kit must be used and it has to be made this Scouting year.

There are specific regulations for the construction of the Kub Kars and the Scout 18 Wheelers. All participating vehicles must adhere to these regulations. If a copy of the regulations are required contact Ray Dunn.

Registration

Groups are to submit a completed registration form by 15 Mar 18. Cheques are to be made out to 38th Edmonton Garrison Scout Group. All participants must be currently registered members and the current uniform should be worn.

There will be pre-registration for Kub Kars the week of the rally. It is highly encouraged that Packs use this time to register their Kars to reduce lineups at the event.

During the event, registration areas will be set up for each of the three Sections.

Activity Crest

Suggestions for crest designs must be in by the next meeting on 15 Mar. Basic size should not exceed 4"x3". Maximum of seven colours on the crest.

Lunch

We are looking for a volunteer to coordinate this activity and Volunteers to prepare and serve the food.

A Hot Dog lunch will be provided for participants. The number shown on the initial registration form will be the number allocated for the Group/Section.

The lunch will be issued by Group/Section. One or more Scouters will collect their meals for their Section. In the past we have had the Beavers eat first, then Cubs and then Scouts. This sequence was established as the schedule had indicated the Section would be finished in that order. This has proven not to be the case and it was decided that a Section could place their order once all the members of their Group in that particular Section had completed their activity.

If an individual has special dietary needs, the Group will have to provide food for that individual.

Group Laydown Areas – Groups will be allocated areas along the wall to place their clothing and kit.

Tracks – Tracks are required as follows:

Beavers – 3 tracks

Cubs – 12 tracks

Scouts – 2 tracks

Tracks have to be sourced for the activity. When possible, we are asking the Group that provides the track to volunteer to run the track.

Pit Stop

Volunteers are required to operate the Pit Stop.

A Pit Stop will be set up to provide a repair shop for vehicles during the Rally. During the registration phase, the Pit Stop will be available to reduce weights of vehicles so they meet the regulation weight. The Pit Stop will not have extra weights available to add to vehicles.

Graphite Application – Only dry graphite is authorized for use. Once the Rally commences the addition of graphite is not authorized.

Opening Ceremony

The Rally opening will commence at 1000 hrs with each Section conducting their opening ceremony, eg Beavers RIVER Banks, Cubs Grand Howl. After the Section Openings, we will be sing O Canada and then do a ceremonial first race starting with Beavers.

PA System – - Ray will contact the Scout Centre

Scales – Required for Cubs and Scouts

Kub Kar size box – Ray
