Policies

Trimester I will run from September 19th through December 14th. Online registration forms must be submitted no later than Wednesday, September 7th.

Space in each after school club is limited. **Clubs will be filled on a first-come-first-served basis.** All clubs have a maximum occupancy. Please note: Your child will only be registered for the selected club once the online form has been completed and submitted. Fees will be billed and paid through your TADS account.

Refund Policy:

- Prior to the first session: A full refund minus a \$10 processing fee will be returned.
- After the first session: A prorated refund based on the values of the club minus a \$10 processing fee will be returned.
- After the second session and beyond: You can opt to switch your child to another club (pending availability and permission from the instructor), but no refunds will be returned.
- No refunds will be issued in the event the school closes or has an early dismissal for a weather related (i.e. snow, flood, etc.) or other emergency.

Financial Questions and Concerns:

- All financial questions and concerns should be brought to the attention of the business office.
- All outstanding balances must be paid before the next beginning of the next trimester. In the event that a balance has not been paid by that time, you will not be permitted to register your child for any clubs during the following trimester.

Carpool:

- All carpool changes must be made in writing by 2pm by emailing Rachel Schenkler at rachels@benporatyosef.org.
- **Please be prompt when picking up your carpool.** Please note: Clubs end at 4:20pm. Students will be brought to the front of the buildings and their names will be called on the carpool line. There is no need to enter the building.

Instructor Absence:

- In the event an instructor absence on the day of his or her assigned club, a substitute will be provided. Every effort will be made to find a substitute who can facilitate the club in a manner that is similar to the usual instructor. Please note:

It can be especially difficult to find suitable substitutes, especially for the more complex clubs.

Lack of Club Interest:

- If there is not enough interest in a particular club (as determined by the instructor) the club will be cancelled. The option of registering your child for another club or receiving a refund will be afforded to you.
