

Boundary training offered in January by Committee on Ethics

The presbytery's Committee on Ethics will be host to a Level 1 boundaries training, entitled "To Bless the Space Between Us," on negotiating interpersonal boundaries, ethics, power dynamics, confidentiality, and self-care in a ministry context. This training is required for all teaching elders when they join the presbytery, and is also appropriate for youth directors, music directors, Christian education staff/leaders, and ruling elders — particularly those serving on personnel committees.

The training will be offered Monday, Jan. 22, at Oak Grove Presbyterian Church in Bloomington. Check-in starts at 8:15 a.m., and the program runs from 8:30 to 3 p.m.
