Articles should be 500-2,000 words in length and need to be submitted by the November 30, 2018 deadline to be considered for inclusion in the 2019 OAM Planning Guide. Submission does not guarantee inclusion in the 2019 OAM Planning Guide and articles may be maintained to use at a later date. POAMN reserves editorial rights of all articles submitted.
