After the meal where we will hear the story for the day, groups will disperse to their different activities. This includes options for adults. As St. John has an intergenerational approach to faith formation, it seems only appropriate to include all generations in our VBS programming.

Different Curriculum!

This year's VBS curriculum comes from the Society of St. Andrew. The Society of St. Andrew is a faith based non-profit organization looking to address hunger by focusing on the **96 billion pounds of food wasted** every year in the United States. Referred to as "gleaning," volunteers with the Society of St. Andrew collect crops from fields and orchards left after harvest. Year one of the two-year Abundance Orchard VBS program focuses on Old Testament stories revolving around food. In fact, the meal for each evening will be derived from the meal in the story. The program materials are available at no cost and the program is designed to be earth conscious, including tips throughout on ways to practice good stewardship of resources.
