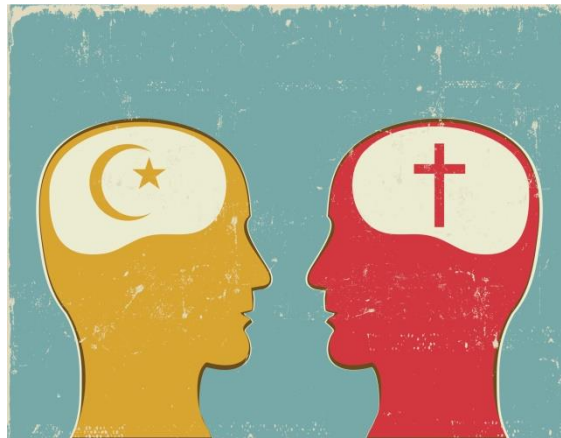


ADULT SUNDAY SCHOOL

Christianity and Islam is a unique study for a unique time. Each session covers a major area of the world's two largest religions, comparing and contrasting them in a way that brings greater understanding of each. We will also view thought-provoking videos, and from time to time will host guest speakers. This study is especially for adults who have little knowledge of Islam other than what they have seen in the news, or heard in political rhetoric or provocative speech. This study aims at providing a general understanding of the differences and similarities between these two great religions. Participants are welcome to “come and go” as it suits them; it is not necessary to participate in every session, or from the beginning. Join us whenever, and however often, you are able and inclined. Participants are asked to contribute \$10 to help cover materials.

Please note: As the purpose of this course is to seek better understanding of our neighbors’ faith, it is expected that we are mindful of the Eighth Commandment, seeking, as Luther teaches in the Small Catechism, to interpret our neighbors’ actions in the best possible light. Participants will be asked to make a covenant that we seek to understand our Muslim neighbors’ beliefs, identities and values to the end that we can better love them. Anyone is welcome to participate, but it is expected of participants that the tone of discussion will be civil and respectful of people of all faiths.
