GO Conference Overview

Every year, Christians from all over New England gather for two days of worship, prayer, equipping and encouraging. While New England may be one of the more challenging regions of our country for the Gospel, it also is one of the most rewarding. God is moving in our region in unique and powerful ways. Christians from every state are committed to living a disciple-making life focused on doing justice, loving mercy and walking humbly with God.

On February 16-17 at the MassMutual Center in Springfield, MA, the GO Conference will bring together those followers of Jesus hungry to grow in their capacity to go make disciples in their everyday lives. We will worship together, pray together, get equipped together and encourage another.

Workshop Topics

The GO Conference combines dynamic, inspirational plenary session speakers and New England-focused workshops to inspire and equip people to bring the hope of Jesus to their communities in practical ways. The workshops communicate how to translate and apply the four major themes of the conference into a New England context.

This year, we will offer 18 one-hour workshops. Audience interaction/participation is highly valued by conference participants. We are looking for partners to create workshop environments where participants learn from the facilitator and work with other participants to apply the content, not mini plenary sessions. Participants expect an experiential learning environment and the opportunity for networking with other New England Christians and ministries.

Here are the four themes for the weekend. Each workshop will fall under one of these themes.

- **EVERYDAY JUSTICE WORKSHOPS:** Fighting injustice is central to making new disciples of deeply skeptical New Englanders who often see the Christian faith as only interested in filling buildings and supporting their programs. Led by New Englanders doing amazing justice work, these workshops will equip you to stand with the oppressed and fight injustice in New England in practical ways.
- **LOVING MERCY WORKSHOPS:** Sharing the Gospel in New England means creating space on our sofas and in our sanctuaries for the broken, unredeemed outcast Jesus loves. Our Love Mercy workshops are for those wanting to explore ways in which individuals, churches, and businesses in New England are creating radically merciful and welcoming environments for sinners and tax collectors to meet Jesus.

- **WALKING HUMBLY WORKSHOPS:** Humility allows us to enter into the world of the broken and lost. We are able to give grace only when we daily walk humbly in the grace of God. Our Walk Humbly workshops focus on equipping you with soul care strategies to humbly walk close to Jesus so you can effectively share the truth of Jesus from a place of spiritual health and vulnerability.
- **DISCIPLES MAKING DISCIPLES WORKSHOPS:** All of us are called as individuals to be a witness of God's grace and mercy to those around us. Our churches also ought to be effective witnessing communities to their cities. The Make Disciples workshops equip you with New England-tested strategies to be effective in building relationships, sharing Jesus, inviting people to follow him and seeing new commitments to Jesus in New England.

 - Presentation topic description with 3 learning outcomes (should include a 3-4 sentence paragraph for publicity)
 - Presentation summary including how the presentation topic fits with the GO Conference theme
 - Delivery method: how will the presentation engage attendees through audience participation and discussion? Will it be a panel, single lecture with Q/A, guided table discussion?
 - Names, pictures, short biography and contact information for all presenters
 - Headshot picture should be 300 x 300 image, 72 dpi or better
 - Biography and PR blurb (150 words or less) for publicity
- If you offer curriculum or services of any kind, the workshop is not an infomercial for your service or curriculum (participants should walk away equipped for ministry whether or not they use your services in the future)
- Promote your participation in the event on your social media sites
- Provide your own printed pieces and/or promotional collaterals to hand out to participants in your workshop
