2017-18 "SeaPro" Club: Q&A

What Is A "SeaPro" Court?

A "SeaPro" court is a regular seasonal court with a selected tennis pro on it every week for the full 33 week season. The court is managed by the Captain & Players. The cost of the court varies by time/day with an additional fee for a pro.

What Is A "SeaPro" Club?

The "SeaPro" player is our most enthusiastic, dedicated player who has made a significant commitment to their tennis. They typically play multiple times a week, supplement group instruction with privates, participate in USTA Leagues & join regular special event opportunities. They're the heart & soul of tennis programming at a club. The "SeaPro" club is not a new physical space but more of an acknowledgement of their support.

I Assume There's No New Dues & What Do We Get For This Distinction?

No and the 2017-18 Seasonal Rates have stayed the same as current. Each enrolled "SeaPro" player will be entitled to a **complimentary one hour private tennis lesson with their tennis pro** to be scheduled during the '17-18 season. Work with your professional on timing and how it can fit into the objectives of instruction for the group.

Each "Sea Pro" player will also **receive complimentary Open Time during the two Holiday breaks (11/23-11/26/17 & 12/23-1/1/18)**. There will also be a complimentary fall & spring special event just for "SeaPro" players.

If I'm on four "SeaPro" Courts Do I Get four Private Lessons?

We love the concept of 4 "SeaPro" courts! And yes you do- enjoy!

I'm a 1/3 Share In One Court, 1/6 In Another, etc... How Does That Work?

As long as you're a regular scheduled player (not a one time sub) you're entitled to one private lesson per "SeaPro" court. Life's too complicated to calculate proportions of this. If you're a regular player, you're in!

My Group Doesn't Play During The Holidays, Can I Book Open Time & Bring Family?

Yes, as long as the reservation is in your name go for it! They'll be some minor restrictions at a later date which will be common sense related (ex. you can't book 4 hours back to back, etc.)
