Return to FPC-Friday, June 28th- 2:00pm


Who: Rising 7th, 8th, and 9th graders are invited to participate.

Where: Massanetta is located just outside of Harrisonburg, VA, which is about a two-hour drive from FPC!

Lodging and Meals: We will be staying in Massanetta's hotel consisting of 2 room suites with twin beds in each room and a hall bathroom connecting the two. Linens are provided, and there is air conditioning! Meals are provided by the conference center; however, students will need additional money for a meal on the way there and on the way home.

Cost: This includes lodging, meals while at Massanetta, and transportation. Massanetta is reevaluating their program costs, so we will have a price announced after they announce their program cost. Scholarships through Massanetta and First PC will be available.

Deposit and Registration: Students can register at the spring meeting for summer programs. Registrations are on a first come, first serve basis and spots are limited.



Sign-Ups

Trip sign-up this year will be every Sunday from September 9th through November 4th in the Fellowship Hall before or after Youth Group. You may also sign up with Wilson or Elise any Tuesday, Wednesday or Thursday afternoon during the enrollment period in the church office, from 2:30 - 5:00 p.m.

Each youth and a parent must sign up in person with Wilson or Elise and a non-refundable deposit is due at the same time.

Spaces are limited on this trip. If it fills up, a waiting list will be created.

Trip Costs

The total cost of this trip includes the preparation costs, ASP fees, van rentals, fuel, supplies, and some of the meals. The Youth Ministry budget will cover part of the total cost, and your family is asked to pay the remaining balance. Partial and full scholarships are available for anyone in need, and are strictly confidential.

➤ Your Cost: **\$400.00**

➤ Non-refundable deposit of **\$100.00** is due **at sign-up**

➤ Second payment of **\$150.00** is due no later than **March 3, 2019**

➤ Final payment of **\$150.00** is due at the preparatory Youth/Parent meeting which will be held on **May 23, 2019**



The Commitment


