2017 Chili Cook-off

Rules and Regulations

The TCAA Field Day Chili Cook Off is being held on Friday, May 19th from 10:00 am to 12:00 pm at Richardson Practice Tee.

1. All contestants must be members of CAI.
2. Please register at www.dfwcai.org. All registration is in advance of the cook-off. **There will be no on-site registration the day of the cook-off. The cost is \$100 per team. Each team is allowed 2 participants.**
3. A chili entrant may be an individual or a team and will need to be able to dispense chili into tasting cups and serve to the public. CAI will not provide your service to the public for you.
4. Assigned area must be set up and chili must be completed and **READY TO SERVE** by Noon. Set up will begin at 9:00 am Friday, May 19th.
5. All entrants must provide a table for set-up, a container to keep the chili in, their own stoves (if applicable) as well as an extension cord, cooking utensils, and ingredients. The chili may be in a crock-pot or electric roaster to maintain chili's temperature. **Taster cups, to dispense samples to the crowd, & spoons will be provided for you.**
6. CAI will provide an assigned area for all contestants.
7. Chili must be cooked from scratch at home. Each cook must prepare at least 10qts. of chili (1-2 pots) to be eaten by the attendees as well as judged by the selected judges.
8. Chili is to consist of any kind of meat cooked with chili peppers, spices or any other ingredients. Beans are allowed. No pasta please.
9. No bare hand contact with food is allowed. Hand washing facilities are available. **REMINDER: Contestants must wash their hands after using toilet facilities, coughing/sneezing and handling soiled equipment, etc.**
10. All food must be covered when not in use to protect from customer handling, coughing, sneezing or other contamination.
11. No deliberate sabotage to another contestant or their entry will be tolerated and such an act would lead to automatic disqualification.
12. All entrants shall deposit their trash in their surrounding area into a near by trash dispenser. Entrants will gather all belongings they brought with them upon leaving and are responsible for clean up of their area.
13. Decision of winner is final!
14. CAI is not responsible for any type of lost or broken item that belongs to any contestant.
