This translates into increased productivity for your full-time staff. # EMPLOYER'S RESPONSIBILITIES FOR THE PATHWAYS INTERNSHIP PROGRAM

Y.O.U.'s experience with internship programs has shown that highly engaged companies and mentors will have a more successful and meaningful experience. Responsibilities for Y.O.U. internship employers:

• Provide meaningful and challenging educational assignments for the intern closely related to their educational track, career goals and/or learning contract.



- **Provide a safe and appropriate working environment** which complies with all federal and state laws, affirmative action and equal employment opportunities.
- Plan for effective supervision designate an individual to act as the intern's mentor/ supervisor.
- Provide Y.O.U.'s mentor training curriculum to the organization's mentor(s).
- **Encourage open lines of communication**, offering consistent constructive feedback on the intern's performance.
- Contribute to the student's professional exploration and development by including them in staff meetings, organizational activities, and potential networking opportunities.

### STUDENT CRITERIA TO BE CONSIDERED FOR THE PATHWAYS INTERNSHIP PROGRAM

- OVERALL GPA OF 3.0; (some exceptions may be granted)
- EXCELLENT ATTENDANCE AND PUNCTUALITY DURING TWO RECENT SEMESTERS
- COMPLETION OF AN INTERNSHIP APPLICATION
- SUBMISSION OF A SCHOOL TRANSCRIPT AND REFERENCE LETTER
- AVAILABILITY AND FLEXIBILITY TO COMPLETE A 120 (or summer 180) HOUR INTERNSHIP
- PROPER BUSINESS ATTIRE AND GROOMING
- ATTENDANCE AT ORIENTATION/BOOTCAMP SESSIONS
