### **Course Description**

This class is sponsored by the Kansas City Metro Animal Response Team and hosted by Leawood Police Dept. This class is designed for Animal Control Officers, First Responders, CART and CERT team members; and any personnel that may be tasked with assistance in a mass care disaster or emergency situation. Building off the Kansas animal decon program built in 2010, participants will start with a lecture presentation at the Leawood Justice Center classroom; and finish the day working with live animals in a full scale decon scenario. This training is designed to equip responders with awareness knowledge of or mass care decontamination operations that can be applied in small and large scale situations. Participants will be required to work for a short amount of time in Tyvek PPE to receive a certificate for this training.
