

Re: Options for Voters

The next general election will be held on Monday, October 16, 2017. Edmonton Elections works diligently to ensure that voting stations are accessible to everyone. When choosing voting station locations, we make every effort to use public buildings; however, in some voting subdivisions it is not always possible to find a suitable public building. In these instances, Edmonton Elections must use a building belonging to a faith organization (the lobby or basement, not the sanctuary). We understand this may pose a challenge to voters with certain beliefs.

To address this issue, Edmonton Elections has ensured that all six advance voting stations are located in public buildings. The advance voting stations will be open October 4 through October 13th, from 1 pm to 7 pm, including the statutory holiday on October 9th.

Because we believe that exercising one's right to vote is an integral part of the democratic process, we encourage voters to check the location of their regular Election Day voting station and to determine if they would prefer to take advantage of their advance voting opportunity instead.

Voters can now locate their Election Day voting station using the **Where to Vote** online tool or they can wait until they receive a **Where to Vote** card in the mail in early October.

Advance Vote locations

Voters must use the voting station that is assigned to their ward.
