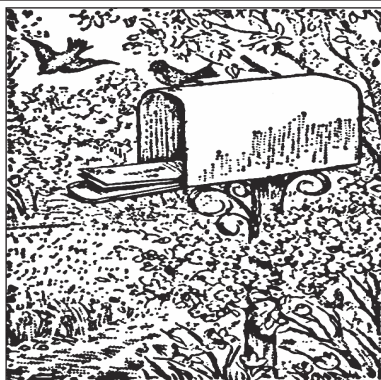

Bless This Home

Helpful Household Hints

The crisp fall air is here to stay, so it's a good time to work around the house. Lighten your chores by using these helpful hints sent in by your Fellow Members, and let us know how you stay organized and the cleaning tips you use as well!

STAIN REMOVAL

Since the dirt rings in collars are oil stains, shampoo for oily hair will remove them. Rub it into the fabric before washing the garment.

Remove rust spots from chrome car bumpers using a piece of tin foil dipped in Coca-Cola.

Lemon juice and salt rubbed into a paste, will remove rust stains from clothing.

Have you ever walked along a beach and stepped on tar balls? Try using salad oil to remove the tar from your feet.

KITCHEN TIPS

Soak limp lettuce leaves, celery and carrots in ice water for an hour. They will become crisper.

Fill a scorched pan halfway with water and 3-½ tablespoons of baking soda. Boil for 10 minutes and the burnt food will loosen and float to the top.

Hard, refrigerated butter will soften in the microwave in 30 sec-

onds on the defrost setting. But make sure you don't leave it in too long!

HOUSEHOLD TIPS

Moth-proof clothing by wrapping it in newspapers, which smell better than mothballs.

Put candles in the freezer before using them. They will last much longer.

Dig your nails into a bar of soap before doing dirty work. This will prevent dirt from getting under them.

Wipe your shoelaces with a wet cloth after tying them. They will stay tied all day

Thread a needle more easily by dipping the end of the thread into colorless nail polish beforehand.

Loosen a rusted bolt by applying a cloth soaked in a carbonated soda to the rusted bolt for several minutes.

CANDLE POWER

Fill your candle jars with a layer of raw beans before putting in a pillar candle. It creates a nice decoration and the beans will keep the candle steady and capture wax drops.

NO LOOSE ENDS

Mark the end of the scotch tape in a dispenser by rolling it up with a toothpick at the end.

Fall harvest time is here, and farmers' markets are piled high with ripe, local produce. Here are some tasty recipes from your Fellow Members. Share your favorites with us, too!

SIX WEEK MUFFINS

This recipe is just right for busy folks. Make the fixings once, and cook these muffins whenever you feel like a tasty snack. We're glad Member Vivian D. of Wisconsin told us about them.

Ingredients: 15-ounce box raisin bran . . . 1 quart buttermilk . . . 5 cups flour . . . 5 teaspoons baking soda . . . 2 teaspoons salt . . . 1 cup vegetable oil . . . 1 cup brown sugar . . . 1 cup white sugar . . . ½ cup honey . . . ½ cup molasses . . . 4 eggs.

In a large bowl mix raisin bran and buttermilk. Let stand while mixing flour and rest of dry ingredients in another large bowl. Add sugars, honey, molasses, oil and eggs to bran and milk, stirring well to mix thoroughly. Add flour mixture and stir well. Fill greased muffin cups ¾ full.

Bake at 400 degrees for 15 to 20 minutes. Bake just the amount you need, and store the rest of the dough, tightly covered, for up

to 6 weeks in your refrigerator.

FESTIVE APPLE SALAD

This is a quick and pretty salad that can make any meal a party. Member F. D. of Florida uses the abundant crop of fall apples to make this treat for her family. It's good, and good for you, too!

Ingredients: 2 medium unpeeled apples, cored and chopped . . . 2 ribs celery, chopped . . . ½ cup each of chopped dates and chopped nuts.

Mix all the ingredients with mayonnaise to moisten. Chill and serve on lettuce leaves.

LEMON PUDDING CAKE

Member Mrs. Lewis R. from New York came up with this lemony pudding that makes its own cake-like top as it bakes.

Ingredients: Juice and grated rind of 1 lemon . . . 3 eggs, separated . . . 1 cup sugar . . . 1 heaping tablespoon flour . . . 1 heaping tablespoon butter, melted . . . 1 cup milk.

Mix sugar and flour with milk until dissolved. Slowly add beaten egg yolks, butter and lemon juice and rind. Beat egg whites until stiff, and fold in. Pour into 8-inch square pan and bake at 350 degrees for 45 minutes.

Otherwise, some or all of your property will be split up according to state law which may leave your property in ways you did not want or intend.

Therefore, whether or not you include a bequest to Life-Study Fellowship, we encourage you to seek the services of an attorney to have a will drawn up if you have not already done so.

“I Was Just Trying To Fit In Somewhere!”

I was born in Birmingham, Ala., a child of the early 60s. I was the last child born in my God-fearing family. My mother and dad raised five healthy children, two boys and three girls.

My mother loved the Lord, and her whole life seemed to be centered on His word. She would make us attend church every Sunday, including Sunday School. I didn't like it at first, but I grew to like it later. Mom also introduced me to Life-Study Fellowship during the tough times in my life. This tragedy led me to do things that I regret to this day. I started drinking alcohol, smoking drugs and other bad things. In my heart I knew it was wrong. I was just trying to fit in somewhere. I was hurt and afraid. And yet, I felt God watching over me through all this time. I am so thankful He continued to bless me with the things I needed.

My mother was hurt about my behavior, and told me I should get back on the path with God. I resisted at first, but the Lord gave me the chance to clean up before my parents passed away.

My prayer is that my story about how God moved in my life, will reach a soul who is lost. I would like to encourage them to trust in the Lord, because there truly is light at the end of the tunnel.

So, we hope we've inspired you to look at and read the Bible differently, Dear Member. May you be guided by the power and meaning of its Verses!



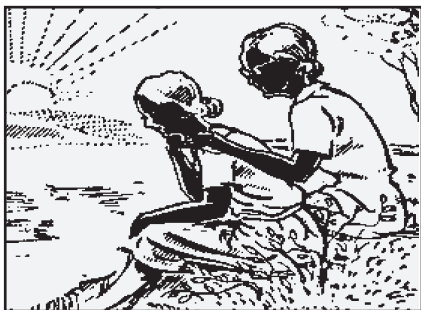
“At One Time, My Friends, It Was So Hard For Me!”

If You Make A Mistake, Don't Let It Weigh Upon Your Mind!

Yes, we've all heard or said these expressions, and read many stories from our Fellow Members about mistakes they've made and how they learned to correct them. In fact, the Bible Verses and other features in every Faith Magazine offer learning tools to help us do that.

But what about the mistakes you make that cause inner guilt. Wouldn't it be nice if you could just "erase" them?
