Over the past five years, Goldstein has worked with the Southern Nevada International Code Council to develop scholarship grant programs with the Public Education Foundation for high school and college students who are majoring in the construction-related fields of architecture, engineering and construction management.

The Public Education Foundation's goal is to bring change to various educational programs in Southern Nevada, working with students, teachers and administrators, and working on several programs vital to the educational challenges in the community. Recently, the Public Education Foundation awarded more than \$1.1 million to local students for scholarship grants to various higher education programs.
