

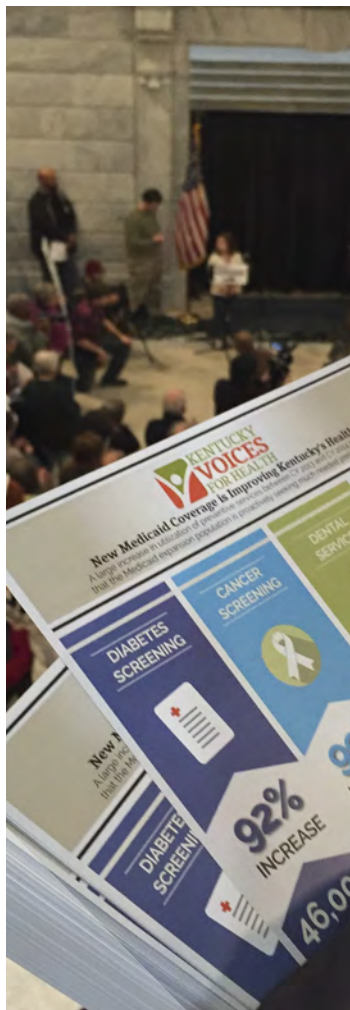
ADVOCACY FOR COMMUNITY IMPACT: TRAIN-THE-TRAINER WORKSHOP
