



Key Features

- SharePoint 2016 support.
- Previews can now be located either below or to the right of the file list.



- Search Site Tree now supports *Any of these words* searches.



When this option is unchecked (default), *Search Site Tree* returns only items that contain the entire entered phrase in their title. When checked, *Search Site Tree* returns items where the title contains ANY of the entered words.


- Support for Group by Views defined as '*Expanded*' by default in SharePoint.
- Customisable search panels on SharePoint Online or Client Side Only servers.

SharePoint Online

- Nodes to Trigger Filter* no longer applies to SharePoint Online or Client Side Only servers. When expanding a tree view node on these server types the filter dialog is only displayed automatically when more than 500 child nodes exist or a time out occurs. This is no longer required due to the tree navigation performance improvements in MacroView DMF 8.4.
- Items deleted from SharePoint Online are added to the recycle bin.
- Resolves an issue with the display of file list items on servers that are pushed via Group Policy.
- Resolves an issue with opening Excel 2016 documents from SharePoint Online.
- Resolves issues with expanding and filtering files using metadata navigation.

Performance Improvements

- Performance when navigating on SharePoint Online or Client Side servers has been improved and as a result, *Nodes to Trigger Filter* no longer applies to these server types. When expanding a tree view node on these server types the filter dialog is now only displayed automatically when more than 500 child nodes exist or a time out occurs. A trade-off is that limited access nodes are no longer greyed in tree view.
- On SharePoint 2013 / 2016 and SharePoint Online, the taxonomy picker now utilises search so available terms are displayed quickly even when very large term sets are in use.
- Performance has been improved when uploading files where large numbers of content types, fields or taxonomy fields are in use.
- When bulk emails are drag and dropped from Outlook to DMF or Message a 'Processing' dialog is displayed while files are being prepared for the upload and prior to the upload commencing to indicate that process has been initiated.



- MacroView DMF and Message 8.4 use less memory than earlier versions when repeatedly displaying the DMF Open, Save and Insert dialogs.

Group by Views

- Support for Group by Views that are set to display '*Expanded*' by default in SharePoint.
- Support for Group by Views at folder level.
- Document count is displayed when navigating tree view using managed metadata columns.
- Documents are displayed when using Group by views based on person/group fields.

Optional Module Support

- MacroView Predictive Email Filing (PEF) server options are disabled if the optional module is not licensed.
- Incoming emails containing Tracking Tags are no longer saved automatically by MacroView PEF if the user does not have access to the corresponding location.
- Support added for creating documents sets favourites via MacroView Push Favourites.

Other

- Support for saving Outlook Notes items.
- Corrections to a number of Dutch translations.
- Resolves an issue which prevented the creation of folders using the right-click context menu on pre-existing favourites after upgrading to DMF / Message 8.3.33 or later.
- Invalid characters are removed from uploaded files by default on fresh installation of MacroView DMF or MacroView Message.
- Emails matching incoming email filing rules are no longer saved automatically if the user does not have access to the location specified by the rule.
- Excel documents get the primary focus when opened when another Excel document is already open.

- Resolves an issue with properties not being set if the properties include a keyword column.
- Resolves an issue in MacroView DMF / Message 8.3 which resulted in the *Create Folder* option being enabled even though the capability is turned off in the SharePoint library.
- Resolves an issue with the *Create Document Set* being unavailable on folder nodes in Browse mode and on library and folder favourites.
- Right-click *Refresh* behaviour is now consistent across all tree view node types. Previously this resulted in existing filters being removed on some node types.
- Group Policy templates are now provided in ADMX format. For information on managing and using ADMX files visit <https://technet.microsoft.com/en-us/library/cc709647%28v=ws.10%29.aspx>

Important information about this release

Commencing October 2016 new functionality developed for MacroView DMF and MacroView Message will no longer be supported on Microsoft Office 2007. MacroView will continue to provide break-fix support to existing customers with up-to-date software assurance for their use of earlier versions of MacroView DMF and MacroView Message with Office 2007.

When upgrading from DMF 7.9.5054 through DMF 7.10.38 you must shutdown the DMF local service before installing later versions of the client to ensure unsaved recents and favorites are retained.
