Dear Savio Parents and Students,

This letter is a reminder regarding morning drop-off and after school pickup procedures at St. Dominic Savio Catholic High School. We want to ensure that all drivers and students are safe when arriving to and leaving the school campus.

**Drop-Off:** Savio parents are to drop-off their students in the morning in the parking lot east of the school away from the front entrance. We ask that all drivers make a complete loop by driving north in the right side of the lot and then making a u-turn to head south on the left side of the lot. The area in front of the school is only for people parking and coming into the school office. Students arriving late (after 8:20am) can be dropped off at the front office to obtain a late pass.

**Pick-Up:** All pickups immediately after school are to be done in the parking lot on the east side of the school (area by the football practice field), following the same morning pattern. Vehicles are then to exit directly to Neenah instead of passing through the front parking lot and then exiting to Neenah near Holy Family. Families wishing to visit the front office may park in the front parking lot but are to exit to Neenah on the east side of the parking lot.

**Speed Limit:** Everyone is reminded to drive carefully and slowly in the parking lot at all times. Also, drivers are advised to take care when driving along Neenah Avenue. The posted speed limit is currently 30 miles per hour. The city of Austin recently informed us that they will be converting the road in front of both Savio and Holy Family to a school zone with a speed limit of 20 miles per hour in the coming months. We have already noticed police officers patrolling the area to enforce the speed limit and we anticipate even more patrols when the new school zone speed limit takes effect.

Thank you for your compliance in this matter to ensure the safety of our students, the Holy Family Catholic School community, and people visiting the Savio office. If you notice any concerns in the parking lot area, please contact myself or Mr. Joe Gutilla, Assistant Principal.
