Freshman: babies

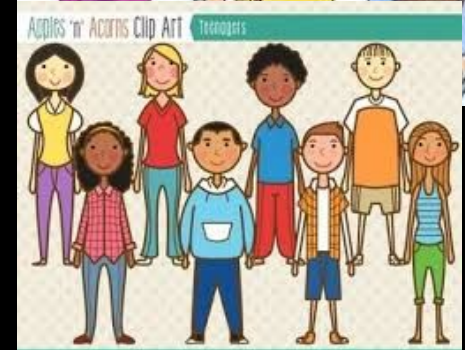
Sophomores: Teachers

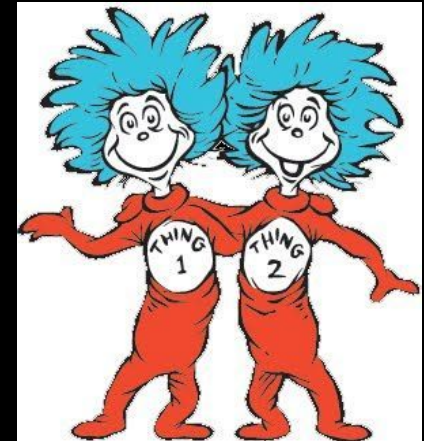


Theme Day 2: Two-by-Twosday

General Rules (Based on Savio Handbook)

Non-Uniform Day Policy: Students are permitted on dress down days to wear the following modest clothing: Appropriate t-shirts, Un-tattered jeans or clothing, Athletic shoes or boots, Dress permitted on special theme days

The following are not permitted at any time in the school building during school hours:

Hats, Sweatpants, pajama bottoms, non-privilege shorts, or workout pants, Non-approved athletic wear (drawstring or elastic-waist slacks or shorts), Baggy or oversize pants, Fatigue-style (camouflage) pants / cargo pants/shorts (except seniors wearing Savio shorts), Sleeveless shirts, Boots with steel toes, Open-toed or open-heeled shoes (sandals or flip-flops of any kind) or five-toed shoes

Dress Code Rules

Gentleman:

- Dress pants/slacks (khakis/dockers)/jeans
 - No tatters or tears in the jeans
- Dress shirts/polo shirts/button downs
 - No T-shirts, Can be short or long-sleeved
- Ties and jackets (optional)
- Any closed shoes
 - Preferably not tennis shoes
- Suits and sport coats are not required

Dress Code Rules Continued

Ladies:

- Dresses, sun dresses, dress pants, blouses, skirts, and shirts which are modest.
 - Modest is defined as: a dress that is not tight fitting or designed in an inappropriate or indecent manner.
- Sleeveless, strapless, spaghetti-strapped, and one-shouldered dresses are allowed
- Any closed toed shoes and sandals are allowed/ no flip flops

Dress Code Rules Continued

The following are not permitted:

- Backs or fronts of dresses that are lower than the shoulder blades
- Cut outs of any kind
- Slits
- Blouses or dresses that reveal cleavage
- Tight fitting outfits
- Tied halter-tops
- No sheer clothing
- No mid-drifts
