Bulldozer (small) D-5 Ideal, D4 & D6 will work well also

Compactor- Vibrator roller for earthwork compaction not asphalt.
Front End Loader- medium size wheeled would be ideal, like a Cat 950
Concrete Pump-Trailerable "Grout Pump" 25 M3 capacity and can take up to $\frac{3}{4}$ " aggregate
Older Concrete mixer- 1990's Mack or International would be great.
