Assertiveness**

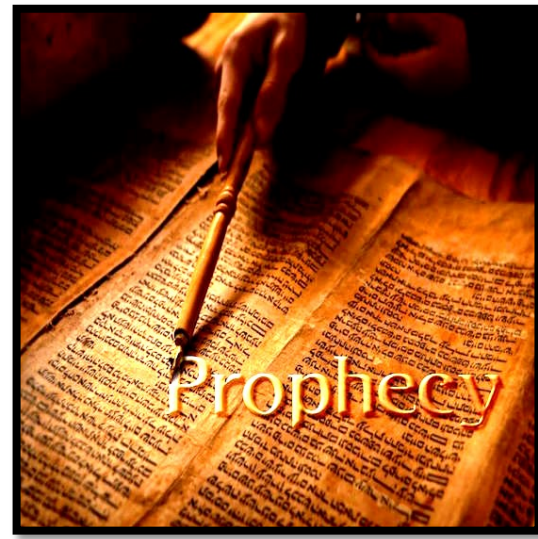

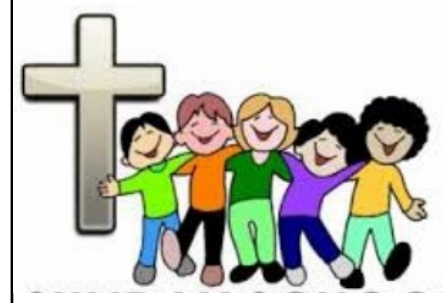
