Important Dates, Entrance Eligibility and General Conditions



Eligible Entrants

- ASID Ohio North Professional, Allied, and Associate members in good standing
- ASID Ohio North Student members in good standing

Eligible Entries

- Projects must be completed and submitted by an ASID Ohio North Chapter member in good standing.
- Projects must have been completed AFTER January 2012
- It is recommended that your project(s) be professionally photographed

Important Dates

- Submission Opens: August 1, 2016
- Submission Deadline: August 19, 2016
- Winners announced at Awards Gala/Annual Meeting: September 15, 2016

Late entries will not be accepted.

Entry Requirements and Conditions - Information you will need to complete the submission process

- **Entrant Information**
Your name and contact information
- **Project Statement:** *See Judging Criteria on page 2 for points to consider in your Project Statement*
500 words or less explaining the design challenges and your solutions. Include notes on unusual design criteria or restrictions, budgetary considerations, code constrictions, space limitations, materials used etc. This should also include client objectives, square footage if applicable, a budget if available and a date of completion or occupancy.

No identifying information for clients, designers, or other involved parties should appear on Project Statement. They will be reviewed by the judges and anonymity needs to be maintained. Projects not following this will be disqualified.

- **Floor plans**
You are allowed to submit up to 5 floor plans of your project.
- **Photography**
You are allowed to submit up to 10 photographs of your project. Each file must not exceed 500 KB.

Videos are not accepted. Hand or computer-generated renderings are only accepted for Student Competition.

- **Payment**
You will be required to provide valid credit card information to process entries.
- **Cost ~ No refunds will be given for any reason**
 - Practitioners (Professional, Allied, Associate): \$100 first entry / \$75 for each additional entry
 - Students: \$0 per entry

- **Online Service**

- **Judging Criteria**

The jury members will be comprised of members of ASID from other chapters. The following guidelines will be provided to the judges:

Clarity of Design Concept: *How well does the design solution meet the challenges as stated in the Project Statement?*

Color Composition: *Did the designer use the color scheme and composition appropriately to achieve their goals as stated in the Project Statement?*

Creativity and Originality: *Did the designer use innovative and creative approaches to achieve their goals as stated in the Project Statement?*

Design Elements: *Did the included materials, lighting and furnishings assist in solving the design challenge effectively?*

Functional Use of Space: *Did the designer develop a functional solution to achieve the goals as stated in the Project Statement?*

Relationship of materials, textures and patterns: *Did the designer's use of design elements achieve their goals as stated in the Project Statement?*

Scale & Proportion: *Is the design proportionate to the scale of the space?*

Success in Meeting Project Statement: *Did the design meet all of the client's goals as stated in the Project Statement?*

The jury, at their discretion, will award one First Place and one Runner-Up for each category
