### **Directions:**

1. Cut 4 pieces of Crumb Cake  $2\frac{3}{4} \times 4\frac{1}{4}$  and create a banner at the end. (make a template for everyone to use to make it quick.) Cut one piece of Crumb Cake  $3\frac{3}{4} \times 5\frac{1}{2}$ .
2. Stamp all 4 images from the Halloween Cookie Cutter Set with Black ink on Watercolor Paper. Color each one individually. (I'll give you colors with each individual picture). Punch them out with the Cookie Cutter Punch.
3. Stamp on the four smaller banners the same images, plus add the "bonus" items directly on the Crumb Cake.
4. Then add the images that you colored with Stampin' Dimensionals.
5. Create your FALL banner by running through three Pumpkin Pie ovals with the Big Shot and the Layering Oval Framelits.
6. Sponge the edges with Pumpkin Pie Ink.
7. Layer together with Stampin' Dimensionals to create the pumpkin. Freehand cut a stem from Old Olive Card stock, and add a burlap thread bow.
8. Cut a  $1\frac{1}{2}$  strip of Watercolor paper and stamp the words FALL from the Layering Alphabet in Crumb Cake ink. Banner the ends.
9. Add the banner overtop the Pumpkin with Stampin' Dimensionals
10. Cut about a 1 yard piece of the Kraft Rope from the Holiday Catalog, and tie a bow on each end. Then clip on the banners with Gold Binder clips. And hang to bring some fall cheer, and show off the versatility of this Suite!



Color using a Blender Pen, and Sweet Sugar Plum and Delightful Dijon. Pumpkin pie on the little Trick or Treat Bag



Using Blender Pens with Pool Party and Delightful Dijon. Nose is Pumpkin Pie. A little bit of Crumb Cake for the straw and face.



Stamp bow with Pumpkin Pie ink and punch out with the Cookie Cutter punch. Add an orange Enamel Dot to the middle of the bow.



Use the Stella of Wink of Wink to blend to make gray and add lots of fun shimmer!! Stamp the bats in black, and add the moon with a sponge dauber and Crushed Curry.
