Directions:

1. Cut Thick Whisper White 8 ½ x 5 ½" and fold. Cut Early Espresso 5 ¼ x 4"
2. Cut the Be Merry DSP 3 ¾ X 5". Stamp the greeting in Cherry Cobbler and run through the Big Shot with the Layering Oval Framelits. Run through a piece of Early Espresso 2 X 5 with the Holly Embossing Folder.
3. Wrap around a piece of the Cherry Cobbler Ribbon and glue down to the DSP. Add the greeting with Stampin' Dimensionals.
4. Stamp the Reindeer in Early Espresso and run through the Big Shot with the Card Builder Framelit set. Add with a Mini Glue Dot.





Directions:

1. Cut Thick Whisper White 5 ½ X 8 ½ and fold in half. Cut Cherry Cobbler 5 x 3 ¾ "
2. Cut three strips of Be Merry DSP 1 X 3 ¾. Layer on the Cherry Cobbler
3. Ink up the ornament stamp with a Garden Green and Cherry Cobbler Marker. Stamp on a Stitched Circle Framelut. Run through the Gold Foil paper with the Layering Circles Framelut. Glue these together.
4. Stamp the greeting from Oh, What Fun in Cherry Cobbler ink on a ½ inch piece of Whisper White. Banner the ends, and staple on a piece of the Gold Mini Sequins. Add to the circle with a Mini Glue dot and put the whole thing on with Stampin' Dimensionals.





Directions:

1. Cut Thick Whisper White 5 ½ X 8 ½ and fold in half. Cut Night of Navy 3 ¾ X 5 and run through the Big Shot with the Softly Falling Embossing Folder, and layer in a piece of Whisper White 4 X 5 ¼.
2. Stamp the Greeting in Night of Navy and run through with the Layering Oval Framelits. Glue to the front of the card.
3. Run through the Trees with the Card Builder Framelits, and sponge the edges with Night of Navy ink, and then add to the card front with Stampin' Dimensionals.
4. Sprinkle on some Basic Rhinestones





Directions:

1. Cut Crumb Cake 8 ½ x 5 ½" and fold. Cut Crumb Cake 5 ¼ x 4" and sponge the edges
2. Cut a piece of Whisper White 2 X 4 ¼ and banner the end with the Triple Banner Punch. Stamp the greeting in Cherry Cobbler
3. Cut the Be Merry DSP 2 X 5 and punch the end with the Triple Banner Punch.
4. Stamp the snowflakes with Crumb Cake on the Card stock, then layer on the banners.
5. Stamp the Poinsetta on the banner and another one on Whisper White paper. Cut it out and add with Mini Stampin' Dimensional.
6. Tie a bow with two strands of burlap and add to the card front with Mini Glue Dots.

Ink: Night of Navy, Cherry Cobbler, Crumb Cake, Early Espresso, Garden Green and Cherry Cobbler Markers

Paper: Whisper White Thick, Whisper White, Night of Navy, Crumb Cake, Early Espresso, Cherry Cobbler, Be Merry Designer Series Paper, Gold Foil Paper

Embellishments: Stampin' Dimensionals, Mini Glue Dots, Double Stitched Cherry Cobbler Ribbon, Burlap, Basic Rhinestones, Gold Mini Sequin Trim

Tools: Big Shot, Layering Circles Dies, Layering Oval Framelits, Card Builder Framelits, Holly Embossing Folder, Softly Falling Embossing Folder, Triple Banner Punch, Stitched Circle Framelits, Pretty Label Punch

Tips:

See if you can borrow an extra set that night from someone in your team so you don't have to share stamps. Also, I would recommend doing some of the Big Shot work for them in advance to make the night run smoothly and quickly!
