Assistance League® of Los Angeles' mission is to improve the lives of impoverished children in our community through philanthropy, dedicated service, and compassionate programs. Our organization is made up of 8 auxiliaries (volunteer service and fundraising groups) through which our members can support specific programs, enabling children to succeed in school and beyond. Our organization also has a League at Large membership for individuals wanting to support all the League's programs and are not affiliated with a specific auxiliary.

Our new League at Large Family Membership* introduces the next generation of philanthropists to Assistance League of Los Angeles' legacy of service. Family volunteering provides many benefits, including:

- teaching kids the importance of caring for others,
- giving adults the opportunity to be positive role models,
- providing your family with new skills,
- introducing your family to new people in the community,
- building a stronger family unit by developing shared memories,
- and making the community a better place for everyone

Like individual League at Large members, Family Membership is for a household who supports all the programs of the League but is not affiliated with a specific auxiliary.



Family Membership member benefits include:

- ❖ **Quarterly Service Days** for the whole family benefitting League programs
- ❖ **Quarterly Assistance League of Los Angeles member newsletters**
- ❖ **Invitations to special events** celebrating our Centennial Anniversary throughout 2018 & 2019
- ❖ **5 tickets to Nine O'Clock Players Theatre for Children's** Fall or Spring Performances. Tickets are redeemable for "Family Membership Celebration Day" at *Oz* (Fall 2019) or *James and the Giant Peach* (Spring 2019) and includes an after party hosted by the Nine O'Clock Players.

Annual Membership Cost:

- ❖ League at Large Family Membership dues are \$175 annually, and includes:
 - Assistance League of Los Angeles Dues of \$100 (100% tax deductible)
 - 5 Theatre for Children Tickets for \$75 (Non-tax deductible)

*Family Membership can include up to 5 immediate family members and must include at least one adult, 2 maximum per household. Membership is for a single household address. Children are considered infant to 17 years old (over 18 is considered an adult and would need an individual League at Large membership). Parents or guardians must sign a waiver for themselves and their children and accompany minors to all activities. In addition to participating in Quarterly Service Days, adult members are invited to volunteer for individual League programs 3 times a year and may be invited to upgrade their membership for the relevant auxiliary supporting those programs.

- ❖ **Spring 2019** (March, date tbd): New shoes and hygiene kits prep member event benefitting Operation School Bell




