Texas Capitol Summer Internship Program

Application Deadline: March 1, 2017

APAPA-ATC Capitol Summer Internship Program in Austin is designed to prepare college students to become future leaders in the State of TX. This program provides an opportunity for students to develop their leadership skills, gain public policy experience and become civically engaged.

The internship program will develop:

- Political awareness and civic engagement
- Understanding of government and legislative processes
- Professional and leadership qualities
- Networking & Team work skills with other fellow interns

Eligibility

The program is open to all Texas resident undergraduate and graduate college students.

Selection Criteria

Applicants will be selected on the basis of:

Demonstrated leadership & Community Service

Interpersonal skills, Written and verbal communication skills

Program length and stipend

Orientation & Training will be held last week of May, 2017.

The six-week program runs from June, 2017 through August, 2017.

Interns will receive a stipend in the amount of \$750 for successful completion of the program.

Students are responsible for their own housing, transportation and insurance.

Requirements

Attend APAPA-ATC's Voter & Election project in Austin.

Work six weeks' minimum in your assigned office.

The hours are flexible depending on the placement office.

Be available to attend any workshops. Workshops include leadership training, public speaking, voter's registration, personal finance, project assignments and guest speakers.

Complete 20 volunteer hours for APAPA Austin TX Chapter.
