The November Meeting

Friday, November 16 - Countryside Day

The November Meeting commences on Friday, Countryside Day, a tradition dating back over two decades where money is raised for the Countryside Alliance and Racing Welfare.

This year's raceday looks set to be as exciting as ever with a number of different Countryside themed events taking place before and during racing.

It wouldn't be Countryside Day without a demonstration from working gun dogs. The dogs, along with ferrets and a hawk, will be in the paddock between 11.10am -11.30am and on the members' lawn between 12.10pm -12.30pm.

Alice Plunkett, the ITV Racing presenter, will be taking part in a side saddle demonstration in the paddock at 11.30. Alice will showcase this traditional way of riding, normally by female riders, and explain the difference between side saddle and normal saddle as well as the history of side saddle.

Other displays include one from Denius Parson, who is an architectural chainsaw sculptor based locally in Painswick, Gloucestershire. He creates bespoke sculptures and wooden buildings from wood, including tree trunks and large pieces of beautifully patterned wood. Based in the Guinness Village between 11.30am and 12.15pm, Denius will be showcasing this unique art form.

Another four-legged breed will be racing on the day. As well as the six horse races, a pack of trail hounds will race on the course before the first race. Hound trailing is a race between hounds along an artificially laid scent trail. Popular in northern England and Scotland, hound trailing originated in the 18th century as a means of various hunt masters testing their fox hounds against each other in match races. There will be a presentation after the race to the winning hound in the parade ring by Gamegoer Gundogs.

It is a longstanding Countryside Day tradition that after the second race, a number of hunts from the South West and the Midlands will be on course, along with the Cotswold hounds. Racegoers are welcome to join the packs on the racecourse, ground conditions permitting.

It is a fantastic day of racing, with bars and restaurants open to suit all palettes throughout the day. Exhibit 5 - Men in Sheds Sopwith Camel

A half scale reproduction Sopwith Camel. Just over one hundred years ago the RAF was founded by merging with the Royal Flying Corps and Royal Naval Service. The front-line fighter aircraft was the Sopwith Camel F1 and there were 5490 manufactured. Originally the aircraft was fitted with two 7.7 mm Vickers machine guns synchronised to fire through the propeller. The model on display is half scale built from plans from the factory, it has been on display at RAF Fairford and at the Promenade in Cheltenham on Remembrance Day. The challenge was to build a representation of the famous fighter from recycled material, with the environment in mind most of the wings are from pallet wood, the fabric rudder is from a uniform shirt. Men in Sheds are a voluntary Association that helps retired people engage with society where former mates might be lost new ones are there to help, many ex-servicemen and women enjoy the practical nature of the work. <https://menssheds.org.uk>

Exhibit 6 - A Commemorative Tapestry

10 tapestry panels; one is a map of Gloucestershire showing the locations of RFC and RAF stations and another dedicated to the RFC which includes a picture of a Gloucester born WW1 Air Ace. The remaining 8 show the development of the RAF from WW1 until 2008. Each panel is mounted on a metal and wooden frame paying tribute to early aircraft production in the county. Exhibit 7 - F.W. Harvey Society

The F.W. Harvey Society are dedicated to promoting the life and work of F.W. Harvey DCM, the 'Laureate of Gloucestershire' and foremost War Poet during the First World War. He was also a famous broadcaster and was known as the 'poor man's solicitor' for his philanthropy and work for ex-servicemen. Their display will tell the story of his poetry, life and particularly his experience with 5th Gloucesters and as a PoW.

The display will feature Sir Fabian Ware whose foresight led to so many graves being recorded and later cared for. Exhibit 21 – St John's Ambulance

St John's Ambulance will be displaying a restored 'Sympathy' ambulance a vehicle that evolved out of the experience of the First World War. 'Sympathy' played its most important role in the Second World War. The Ambulance was used to rescue casualties from bombed out buildings during the Blitz on London's East End. The Ford Model 'A' vehicle was built at Ford's Old Trafford, Manchester Works. Originally commissioned for St John Ambulance, Sidmouth Division, 'Sympathy' served the Sidmouth area for ten years. During the Second World War 'Sympathy' was transferred for service as a rescue vehicle in the City of London and the East End during the London Blitz. Exhibit 22 – Pates Grammar School

Photographs of the 1916 formation of the cadet force attached to the 1/5th Glousters and archival information related to this. Details of the Girl's School war work, in particular the digging up of the Livorno Lodge gardens (Pate Court) to grow vegetables for the Navy. Exhibit 23 – The Racing Communities Contribution to the First World War

A large display featuring the horses, jockeys, trainers and staff from the racing world who contributed to the War effort designed and curated by Lt-Col John Penley and Rollo Clifford, emphasising the communications between the Yeomanry, racing community and Gloucestershire. It features biographies of leading jockeys, trainers and staff from the racing community who served in the War on the Western Front and in Egypt, Palestine and Mesopotamia.

Exhibit 24 - The Road Coach

Designed by Alfred Gwynne Vanderbilt, the 'Road Coach' was the 'Ferrari' of horse drawn vehicles in the pre-war era. Vanderbilt came to England from the US. He was so moved by the romantic legend of the 18th and 19th Century Road Coach era that he put his considerable resources into horsing road coaches with teams which followed the old coaching routes and carried fare paying passengers. He drove the vehicles himself. His initiative in the early 1900s became known as the 'coaching revival'. Most coaches still in existence date from this period and after and are termed 'revivalist coaches'. Vanderbilt's 'coaching revival' continues to this day. The 'revivalist coach' on display was built ca. 1900 by Cowlard and Selby. On May 1, 1915, Alfred Vanderbilt boarded the Lusitania bound for Liverpool. On May 7, off the coast of Ireland a German U-boat torpedoed the ship, triggering an explosion that sank the giant ocean liner within 18 minutes. This was one of an accumulation of incidents that led to the US joining the war in 1917.

Exhibit 25 – Stroud High School

The war created opportunities for women to take on jobs they had never been allowed to do before. Much of the munitions industry was dependant on women's labour. In 1918 the rights of women were recognised with the Representation of the People Act of 1918 granted the vote to women over the age of 30 who met a property qualification. BetVictor Gold Cup Facts & Figures

Background information

First staged in 1960, the Grade Three BetVictor Gold Cup is one of Jump racing's most illustrious and valuable handicap chases and its history contains the names of some of the sport's finest horses.

The two and a half mile showpiece, first run under its present title in 2016, was known as the Paddy Power Gold Cup from 2003 to 2015, and the Thomas Pink Gold Cup from 2000 to 2002. Whitbread, under the Mackeson brand and then Murphys, backed the first 40 runnings from 1960. 2018 sees the 59th running.

Multiple winners

There have been five dual winners – Fortria (1960 & 1962), Gay Trip (1969 & 1971), Half Free (1984 & 1985), Bradbury Star (1993 & 1994) and Cyfor Malta (1998 & 2002).

No horse has won the BetVictor Gold Cup more than twice.

Most successful owner

The late David Johnson has been the most successful owner with seven successes – Challenger Du Luc (1996), Cyfor Malta (1998 & 2002), Lady Cricket (2000), Celestial Gold (2004), Our Vic (2005) and Great Endeavour (2011).

Most successful trainer

Martin Pipe landed the spoils eight times before his retirement in April, 2006 – Beau Ranger (1987), Challenger Du Luc (1996), Cyfor Malta (1998 & 2002), Lady Cricket (2000), Shooting Light (2001), Celestial Gold (2004) and Our Vic (2005).

Of the current trainers, Nigel Twiston-Davies (1992 Tipping Tim, 2008 Imperial Commander, 2010 Little Josh and 2017 Splash Of Ginge) leads the way with four wins.

Most successful jockey

The great Sir A P McCoy, the record-breaking 20-time champion Jump jockey who retired in April, 2015, has been the most successful rider in the race with four victories – Cyfor Malta (1998), Lady Cricket (2000), Shooting Light (2001) and Exotic Dancer (2006).

Among the current jockeys, Sam Twiston-Davies is the only multiple winner thanks to victories on Little Josh (2010) and Caid du Berlais (2014).

Field size

The biggest field came in 1962 when 25 runners lined up, while the smallest was five in 1966. The current safety limit is 20.

Betting

The longest-priced winners of the BetVictor Gold Cup have been 33/1 shots Chatham (1970) and Senor El Betrutti (1997). The biggest surprise since the latter won came in 2017 with 25/1 chance Splash Of Ginge.

Dunkirk (1965) has been the shortest-priced scorer at 11/10. Favourites have won 14 of the 58 runnings, a strike rate of 24.14 per cent, with Tranquil Sea being the most recent to succeed at 11/2 in 2009.

Weights

Seven winners have defied top-weight – Fortria (1960 & 1962), Dunkirk (1965), Half Free (1984), Bradbury Star (1994), Cyfor Malta (2002) and Al Ferof (2012). The top-weight, which was 12st 7lb when Dunkirk won in 1965, is now a maximum 11st 12lb.

Three winners have carried bottom weight of 10st – Red Candle (1972), Senor El Betrutti (1997) and The Outback Way (1999).

BetVictor Gold Cup & Caspian Caviar Gold Cup

Seven horses have won both the BetVictor Gold Cup and the Caspian Caviar Gold Cup, which takes place over a similar distance at Cheltenham at The International in December. Of the seven winners, only three have achieved the feat in the same season – Pegwell Bay, Senor El Betrutti and Exotic Dancer. The seven winners of both races are:

Imperial Commander is the only horse to win both the BetVictor Gold Cup (2008) and Magners Cheltenham Gold Cup (2010).

Other facts about The November Meeting

The incomparable Arkle, winner of the Cheltenham Gold Cup from 1964 to 1966, made his British racecourse bow in the Honeybourne Chase on the Saturday of The November Meeting in 1962. It was a fantastic day for Arkle's trainer and jockey, Tom Dreaper and Pat Taaffe who, following Arkle's impressive victory by 20 lengths, went on to land what is now the BetVictor Gold Cup with Fortria.

Best Mate, also the winner of three Cheltenham Gold Cups in 2002, 2003 & 2004, gained his first success under Rules in Britain when taking The November Meeting bumper in 1999 and recorded the second chase win of his career at The November Meeting in 2000.

The 2010 Magners Cheltenham Gold Cup victor Imperial Commander won the 2008 BetVictor Gold Cup, while Long Run finished third to Little Josh in 2010 before going on to win the King George VI Chase and the 2011 Magners Cheltenham Gold Cup.

The 2003 Unibet Champion Hurdle victor Rooster Booster defied top-weight to win the Unibet Greatwood Hurdle in 2002. The 2001 Unibet Greatwood Hurdle winner, Westender, finished second to Rooster Booster in the 2003 Unibet Champion Hurdle, a feat mirrored in 2009/10 by Khyber Kim, who chased home Binocular at The Festival.

The November Meeting has only once been held at a different venue from Prestbury Park. A new drainage system was being installed at Cheltenham in 1976, so the then two-day meeting was switched to Lancashire's Haydock Park where Cancellor became the only horse to win the BetVictor Gold Cup anywhere but Cheltenham.
