## From the Pastor's Desk

KEN CASTLEBERRY

**YOU WERE PUT ON EARTH TO MAKE A CONTRIBUTION.** Rick Warren makes this statement in his book, *The Purpose Driven Life*. He explains his statement by saying:

*"You weren't created just to consume resources - to eat, breathe, and take up space. God designed you to make a difference with your life. This is one of God's purposes for your life, and it's called your "ministry" - or service. The Bible says, "God has created us for a life of good deeds, which he has already prepared for us to do" (Ephesians 2:10b, TEV). These "good deeds" are your service to the world. Whenever you serve others in any way, you are actually serving God and fulfilling one of your purposes. You were placed on this planet for a special assignment."*

We seek to continually give you opportunities through our church to make a difference with your service. Let me share some of the opportunities that are immediately before us.

**LANDSCAPING AT OLD CENTER ELEMENTARY** – This project is set for this Saturday morning, June 24th, from 8:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. We will be working to spruce up the outside of the campus.

**PAINTING AT OLD CENTER ELEMENTARY** – This project is set for this Sunday afternoon, June 25th, at 2:00 p.m. We will be painting several interior places in order to provide a more appealing learning environment for the children.

**EXALT THE WORD** – We are joining with other area churches in helping to read the entire Word of God, from Genesis to Revelation, all in one day on this Sunday, June 25th. The opening of John's Revelation places a blessing on a person who reads, and a person who hears the words of John's prophecy. During the days of Ezra and Nehemiah, the entire Torah (Pentateuch) was read aloud in the hearing of all the people as a way of rededicating themselves to God. Israel was to read the entire Torah repeatedly through the years, read it aloud and listen to it being read.

Our church will be reading Matthew 1-14 aloud outside the main entrance to our church at 2:00 p.m. Other churches will be doing the same thing with the other parts of the Bible. Then at 4:00 p.m. a culminating reading for the day will be spoken by a panel of seven voices, in Collins Alumni Auditorium, at Lipscomb University for those who wish to attend. I am excited about us speaking out to God His very Word in this one day. May we honor God by speaking His Word over our city.

**PRAYER FOR CITY OF GOODLETSVILLE** – We are invited to join with other churches in participating in a time of prayer for our city and those who serve the citizens of Goodlettsville (elected officials, city workers, police officers and fire fighters) on Monday, June 26th, from 6:00 p.m. – 7:00 p.m. at the Goodlettsville Help Center. We are hopeful that several of the city's workers will be in attendance so that we can pray for their specific needs.


## STUDENT MINISTRY
