The Rogers Public Education Foundation will host the sixth annual Wall of Distinction banquet in April to pay tribute to the special accomplishments of Rogers School District alumni, teachers, administrators, parents, and supportive community members.

The mission of the foundation is to promote and enhance the quality of education in our community by raising funds and distributing grants to teachers for additional materials or special classroom needs.
