Our Family Empowerment Advocacy Series will be starting on Friday, October 12, 2018. The series will run for five weeks. This series teaches parents, grandparents and guardians of children with disabilities how to advocate for their own children within the special education system as well as how to become an effective member of your child's CSE team. The training includes information about the special education process, including the laws, regulations and policies related to students with disabilities. The training aims to improve communication and develop effective advocacy skills.

Some of the topics to be covered include: Developing an Educational Records Binder, How to Communicate Effectively with your District and Team, What is Advocacy, Understanding the CSE process, Rules and Regulations governing the Special Education Process, Understanding your Child's Evaluations and IEP.

If you register for the series you are committing to attend all of the sessions. The series will run on the following Fridays, October 12th, 19th, 26th, November 2nd and 9th.
