## Short-term Missions Trip Opportunity – Cabo San Lucas/La Purisima, BCS

**February 24-March 3, 2018**

On this trip, we will be serving in a community called La Purisima, about a 7 hour drive from Cabo San Lucas, Mexico. We will be partnering with our MMM missionaries, Dr. Alvaro and Soledad Avila, Dr. Bonnie Barajas and a new church plant in that community, to help meet the spiritual and medical needs. We can use both medical and non-medical volunteers (pre-med students are welcome to join us too). We will be providing medical and dental consultations, foot care, children's health fairs, vision exams and reading glasses, checking vital signs, evangelism and prayer. We will provide an orientation and training. Speaking Spanish is helpful, (we can use translators also), but we can use non- Spanish speakers too. All volunteers must be over 18 year old. You will need a passport book and a willing heart to serve.

**Participation fee: \$500.00** – includes ground transportation in Mexico, travel insurance, meals, housing, t-shirt, and materials for ministry. (Note: this fee does not include airfare to SJD)

**Application and deposit** of \$250 is due by **December 29, 2017**, and balance of \$250.00 is due by **January 24, 2018**.

**Flight Arrangements** (not included in participation fee): All team members will purchase their own ticket, arriving at the airport outside of Cabo San Luis-San Jose del Cabo (SJD) no later than 3:00 pm on Saturday, February 24 and departure flights from SJD must be any time before 2:00 pm on March 3. Flights usually cost between \$400-\$500.00, (depending on where you fly from) early bookings are better prices.

**Housing:** Dormitories/motel

**Food:** Healthy/safe food along with purified water will be provided.

**Health Warning:** According to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention this is a Flavivirus area, which is carried by mosquitos and human contact. This includes Zika, Dengue Fever and Chikungunya. No pregnant women can participate in this trip. We will send more information on how to prevent mosquito bites and will take every precaution possible.
