FLIGHT INFORMATION & TRANSPORTATION

Denver International Airport (DEN)

25 Miles and 30 minutes without traffic

Both **Uber** and **Lyft** are available at Denver International Airport. Please see the respective apps or website for more details on pick-up locations.

Cab service is approximately \$55 each way.

Denver Airport Rail

Travelers can now use A Line, the new rail service from Denver International Airport to LoDo's (lower downtown) Union Station and back. The cost each way is \$9 per person. The Denver airport rail has six stops along the way and takes approximately 37 minutes. The Hyatt Regency is located just less than one mile from Union Station. Once you're downtown, you can walk, Uber or Lyft or grab a cab to complete your journey to the hotel.

Service is from 3:30 am to 1:30 am daily. Frequency is every 15 minutes from 5:00 am -7:00 am and every 30 minutes at all other times.

FACE-TO-FACE

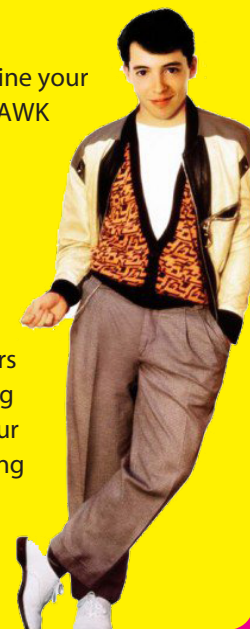
Short 10-minute pre-scheduled meetings between Member-Owners and Vendor Partners to explore business opportunities.

Denver is rich in history, legend and lore! You'll get a great overview of the fabulous Mile High City, including Colorado's spectacular Capitol building featuring an official altitude marker where you can stand exactly one "Mile" High! Take a driving tour of beautiful Denver, including Lower Downtown (LoDo), the Highlands, RiNo and stop on Larimer Square to grab lunch on your own and do a little shopping. During the State Capitol tour you'll see the beautiful stained glass artwork, women's gold tapestry and learn about the Colorado lawmaking process. You will see Mr. Brown's Attic, Capitol Museum and the infamous Gold Dome! The Denver Mint Tour includes the present state of coin manufacturing and history of the Denver Mint.

Rocky Mountain & Coors Brewery Tour

(Includes transportation, Red Rocks Tour, Coors Brewing Tour, Lookout Mountain and entrance to the Buffalo Bill Museum.)

Take a ride into the foothills just outside of Denver where you may visit a few of Colorado's most popular attractions. First stop, Lookout Mountain Nature Preserve where you can catch the best view of the city while passing the buffalo herd overlook. While at Lookout Mountain, tour the Buffalo Bill Museum and grave site. Next, Red Rocks Amphitheater, an acoustical marvel, where 9,000 seats are set in the red sandstone rocks overlooking the city. Finish off the day at Coors Brewery. Get an inside glimpse into how an American favorite brews their rich and satisfying beers, and get a sample too!
