**UPC-Who We Are and What We Do:** We are parents working together to enhance the PV Schools experience for our children. We support you, we give you access to your Superintendent, and we provide relevant programs of interest to you. Ultimately we ADVOCATE for Students, EDUCATE Parents and Community, COLLABORATE with PVUSD and other Educational Organizations, and WORK with the Superintendent to increase the presence of the UPC.

### **Superintendent Comments: Dr. Jim Lee**

- Dr. Lee attended the AADA Equity Summit and was able to share resources with districts around the country and hear meaningful stories. “To have an equity lens you must have an equity mirror.” Dr. Lee was very proud to share the work that PVUSD is doing with the DELTA group and required equity training for PVUSD staff. We have become a leader in equity for school districts across the country.
- School letter grades
  - Parents choose schools for all kinds of reasons but letter grades give scores for specific things that may not be meaningful to parents
  - Dr. Lee advocates for a dashboard view, not a letter grade and cautions parents not to put too much weight on a school’s letter grade

- If the M&O Override doesn’t pass it will have to go to election again next year, which costs the district up to \$500,000 per election and if it doesn’t pass in 2018, PVUSD will have to reduce their budget by 7.5 million a year for three years potentially resulting in a pay cut for staff
