UPC-Who We Are and What We Do: We are parents working together to enhance the PV Schools experience for our children. We support you, we give you access to your Superintendent, and we provide relevant programs of interest to you. Ultimately we ADVOCATE for Students, EDUCATE Parents and Community, COLLABORATE with PVUSD and other Educational Organizations, and WORK with the Superintendent to increase the presence of the UPC.

Superintendent Comments: Dr. Jim Lee

- VIP (Volunteer in Paradise) – national award-winning program and a great volunteering opportunity within the district.
- School letter-grades are coming out – the formula is ever changing and not a valid measure of how your own student is doing. Talking to your student's teachers is the best way to understand how your child is doing. PVUSD is committed to ensuring they are putting the best quality teachers in front of our students to produce well-rounded students and giving all students opportunities to be successful.
- DELTA (District Equity Leadership Team of Advisors) meetings – equity audit was completed to assess how we are taking care of our students and how that is perceived by parents. Advises the cabinet on how to enable equity within the district. The group has been expanded. Reps from every high school, middle school, and feeder group including high school students and more parents.
 - Goal: create cultural proficiency amongst staff in order to work with all students that attend the district
- Dr. Dan Courson's new responsibilities (Assistant Superintendent for Curriculum and Instruction):
 - Supervises curriculum, assessment, fine arts, gifted, special ed, language acquisition, professional development, and technology
 - Working on K-6 ELA curriculum
- PTO Leadership Training October 6th @ 10:00-Noon
- Enrollment numbers – down about 400 students this year, mostly in the elementary schools
 - Still a lot of opportunity for growth in the northern part of the district
- Bus driver shortage is ongoing across the state, including PVUSD
