

The ministries and programs of Bel Air United Methodist Church are categorized according to our church-wide mission: **Love God, Love One Another, and Make Disciples for Jesus Christ**. Brief descriptions of each activity are provided as well as ways in which you can serve (with the exception of those clearly stated in the description). Our underlying intent is to offer a thumbnail sketch for your review so that you can consider where you may wish to serve. Interest forms in the back of the booklet can be completed and turned in at the church office and ministry leaders will contact you; or you can contact the leader via the contact information provided in the back of the booklet. Additional forms can be found in the church office.

If you are curious about what kinds of ministries and programs would be a good fit for your personality and interests, a self-assessing 'Spiritual Gift Inventory' will highlight individual gifts that you have been given. This tool is available at the Information Desk and in the church office. Also, the Adult Discipleship Team would be happy to help you make a selection based on your interests. In whatever ways that you are called to serve, our prayer for you is that you will grow closer to the Lord as you travel with him on this incredible, transforming journey.

MINISTRIES

LOVE GOD

Altar Guild

Prepares and maintains the sanctuary and its furnishings as required to facilitate appropriate and joyful worship of God; recruits acolytes

How to serve: Prepare the sanctuary for worship each week on a rotating schedule; prepare the sanctuary for Christmas and Easter celebrations; train acolytes; guide acolytes on Sunday morning

Bulletin & Spire Fold Team

Stuffs/folds bulletins for Sunday Worship; prepares the monthly SPIRE newsletter for mailing

How to serve: Join the team that meets at specific times on weekdays

Choirs

Chancel Choir

Praises the Lord with song at the 9:20am sanctuary service with occasional guest appearances at other services

Children's Choirs

Showcases children's musical participation in worship services

Cherub Choir → 4 yrs old – 2nd Grade

Wesley Choir → 3rd Grade – 5th Grade

STIX ministry → K - 5th Grade

Youth Choir

Showcases 6th-12th grade youth musical participation in worship services

Communion

Sets the communion table(s) each week for distribution of sacrament of communion

Counting Teams

Counts and records contributions that come into the office by mail or from worship services

How to serve: Join the team that counts after services on Sundays (rotating schedule)

Garden Ministry

Maintains and beautifies the grounds of BAUMC

How to serve: Adopt a garden or area to maintain

Office Volunteers Team

Answers phones, greets people, does odds and ends office work

Tech Support

Provides sound and video support for worship services as well as for special events (weddings, funerals, concerts, conferences, etc)

Worship Teams

11:00 Worship Team

Provides music and prayer for Sunday morning worship

Mount Carmel Praise & Worship

Provides a small, traditional, informal, and intimate service every Sunday at 5PM in a historic 1865 Chapel, located at the corner of Emmorton and Wheel roads

How to serve - Read pastor-selected scriptures at the service

Kingdom Affect

Youth band members provide praise music for confirmation students at the beginning of each confirmation class; provide praise music during worship services occasionally

Adopt a Child

Provides Christmas presents/food to children in need in Harford County

How to serve - *Sponsor a child/family to provide food and gifts at Christmas time*

Blood Drive

Provides venue for American Red Cross to collect blood donations (6 blood drives per year)

How to serve - *Donate blood; volunteer at the Registration Desk on the day of the drive, or volunteer at the Canteen Table on the day of the drive*

Board of Child Care Auxiliary

Operated by the Baltimore/Washington Conference of the United Methodist Church, this organization has given children and their families hope for the future and power in their present lives since 1874

How to serve - *Donate food to the Thanksgiving Food Drive; donate to the spring Cookie Drive; become a member during membership drives*

Boy Scout Troop 777

Promotes the ability of male youth ages 11-18 years to help others, teaches youth patriotism, courage, self-reliance, while instilling virtues such as reverence and duty to God

Card Ministry

Acknowledges the church's awareness of a person's situation and sends out a card of encouragement, compassion, or sympathy

How to serve - *Prepare and mail cards for various people in our church when they are ill, injured, shut-ins as well as the families of deceased members and attenders*

Casserole Ministry

Shows love and concern for people who are healing or need help by preparing a casserole

How to serve: *Prepare a casserole and leave in church office; take a casserole to someone in need*

The Chabadza-Healing Hands Across Zimbabwe

Provides Christ-centered, sustainable, healthcare, health education and medical outreach for the Zimbabwean people through the repair, expansion, and revitalization of five (5) Zimbabwe UMC Medical Clinics in rural Manicaland Province, Zimbabwe.

How to serve – *Participate in fundraising, make presentations to interested groups and travel to Zimbabwe to facilitate clinic renovations*

Children's Christian Center

Educates children with Christian values, prepare preschoolers for entrance into public school, provides school-age children with safe environment before and after school

College Box Ministry

Sends a care package and prayer to each of our college students twice a year prior to finals

MINISTRIES

How to serve - *Donate snacks; purchase gift cards; assist with various administrative needs in the weeks leading up to package preparation; assemble care packages*

Divorce Care

Provides a structured 13-week Christian-based program and support group in accordance with the DivorceCare videos and workbook to guide those undergoing separation or divorce towards a successful healing journey (open to anyone in our church or community)

Easter Ministry

Shares our faith and the message of Easter by providing Easter baskets to children and families in need in Harford and/or Baltimore County

How to serve - *Donate items for the Easter baskets; sort and pack baskets*

Furniture Ministry

Provides low income individuals and those transitioning to permanent housing with furniture to help fill their empty space; receive donations from those who have slightly used furniture who wish to help serve those in need.

How to serve - *Donate gently used furniture; volunteer to collect/deliver furniture; become a certified church truck driver to pick up and deliver furniture*

Grace Connections

Facilitates grace inspired connections between people through Christian expressions in cards, flyers, nature art, business cards, and books; designs and publishes products for use by church ministries

How to serve - *Purchase "Grace Connections" cards when they are*

available for sale (the proceeds support other church ministries)

Grandparents Raising Grandchildren Support Group

Provides a confidential place where relatives can share information and encouragement with those raising children of another family member

GriefShare

Offers hope, help and comfort to those grieving the loss of a loved one in a safe and caring environment using a small group curriculum

How to serve- *Invite someone who is struggling with the death of a loved one to a meeting*

Grief Support Group

Provides caring, Christian environment to help those in the congregation and community who have lost loved ones through death

How to serve - *Invite someone who is struggling with the death of a loved one to a meeting*

Guest Welcome Desk/Greeters

Welcomes first time visitors in the Narthex by handing out a gift and brochure; greets all worshippers as they enter the sanctuary

Hospitality

Hospitality Committee

Provides food services for church events, Confirmation classes, funerals, special events, etc.

How to serve – *set tables, wash dishes, help with food preparation, serve guests, bake desserts for events, etc.*

Mission Dinners

Coordinates and plans dinners to fundraise for various missions and ministries

MINISTRIES

How to serve – *Assist with setup, food preparation, serving, cleanup and dishwashing; support the mission by coming to dinner*

Sunday Morning Fellowship

Provides refreshments for a casual gathering of worshippers before and after Sunday services

How to serve – *Assist with setting up, serving and cleaning up.*

Information Desk

Offers a friendly smile and greeting from the desk each Sunday, meets the needs of newcomers and members, answers the phone, and contacts the appropriate staff for emergencies

How to serve: *Volunteer on a rotating basis to serve at the desk or be a rover*

Local Missions

Provides financial support for New Hope Fellowship (daytime shelter - meals, devotional teaching, spiritual counseling), Anna's House (transitional and permanent housing for homeless women and children in Harford County), and Alpha's Glory (services for pregnancy and pregnancy loss, supports Moms, Dads and infants)

How to serve - *Provide financial giving through BAUMC to the local mission of your choosing*

Manna House Wheels - Bikes

Collects donated bikes to be repaired and provided to Manna House recipients or other organizations throughout Harford County

How to serve - *Repair and clean bikes for those who need transportation*

Neighbors in Need

Family Food

Provides for families that do not qualify for government assistance but still need help to put food on the table each month; operates one (1) Saturday per month (provide non-perishable food, fresh produce and meats, non-food, pet food)

How to serve - *Sort food; pack bags; hand out food and push shopping carts; donate foodstuffs and/or financial support at specific times throughout the year*

Manna House Soup Kitchen

Shares God's love weekly with those who are hungry, lonely, disabled or homeless; provides nutrition through well planned meals and bags of food to take home; engages guests to offer praise through song and prayer

How to serve – *Serve at the soup kitchen; donate food, hygiene products and financial gifts; pray for the guests*

Senior Food Baskets

Packs food bags and delivers to qualified low income seniors throughout Harford County

Parish Nurse

Maintain medical supplies and equipment, such as canes, walkers, wheelchairs, stored in the Parish Nurse closet; maintain the medical box in the church office; respond to any medical situation that may occur during worship

How to serve: *Additional nurses would allow BAUMC to provide medical screenings and health information sessions for church members; additional nurses to respond to medical needs during worship services*

MINISTRIES

Parking Lot Ministry

Welcomes everyone using the parking lot at McComas Entrance; assists those who need help; escorts visitors to their destination

How to serve: *Assist Sunday mornings and at special events at BAUMC*

Pass It On Ministry

Provides financial assistance to Harford county residents once every 12 months for BGE/Delmarva electricity turn-off notices, court-ordered evictions, or security deposits; directs clients to other resources in the county

How to serve – *Financial giving; become a team member (training provided)*

Pew Ministry

Neatens and restocks the pew racks with envelopes, prayer request cards and specialty envelopes

Prayer Ministries

Prayer Team Ministry

Prays for people who provide prayer requests to the church and at Sunday worship services

How to serve - *Join the email prayer chain (prayerchain@baumc.com)*

Wednesday Night Prayer Team

Meets and prays weekly for the spiritual health of BAUMC, its leaders, ministries and programs, as well as the people who are on the prayer chain

Worship Service Prayer Team

Prays for pastors, congregation, and staff before and during Sunday worship time

How to serve: *Meet in prayer chapel during worship services*

Prayer Shawl Ministry

Provides comfort through a crocheted or knitted shawl to those who are hospitalized in nursing homes, grieving, healing, moving away, frail, new mothers, and others; instructs beginners in the craft

How to serve: *Make a shawl or share a shawl with someone in need*

Prison to Praise Jail Ministry

Provides outreach/support to Harford County Detention Center inmates, staff and visitors; raises awareness of KAIROS ministry within state prisons

How to serve - *Minister to those who have been or whose lives are impacted by incarceration within our congregation and community (training required); donate supplies for inmates during collection drives; financial giving through BAUMC*

Russia Ministry

Supports Camp Crystal, a United Methodist Church camp in Russia which serves as a spiritual renewal facility for Christians and helps children with disabilities

How to serve – *Participate in fundraising; travel with the team to Russia*

Scholarship Committee Ministry

Awards scholarships to BAUMC high school graduating seniors pursuing higher education, based on scholarship, character and church involvement; awards “Pay It Forward” scholarships to a youth or adult pursuing higher education beyond high school, based on financial need, determination, and dedication

How to serve - *Direct giving for the scholarship; provide fundraising ideas*

MINISTRIES

Shepherd Ministry

Serves as Christian friends to members of God's family by caring for one another; assists people who are experiencing crisis as well as individuals who are challenged with chronic or serious illness; serves senior citizens by being a friend through notes, phone calls and visits

How to serve – Participate in a training program has been designed to provide background, purpose and necessary details for starting and continuing one's role as a Shepherd

Sports Activities

Promotes fellowship with sports activities with a little friendly competition

Stephen Ministry

Provides faith-based one-to-one care by trained men and women to people experiencing life difficulties such as grief, divorce, chronic or terminal illness, financial troubles, etc

Tiny Tot School

Educates preschool children in a Christian atmosphere, introducing 3-year-olds to the joy of learning and providing 4-year-olds with kindergarten readiness; brings families into an environment of Christian life.

Toy Workshop

Provides toys and gifts to the needy at Christmas; offers opportunity to recycle items in a friendly service environment

How to serve - Donate gently used and new toys, baskets and baby items which will be made available to the sponsors of the Adopt-A-Child program; volunteer in late November and early December to organize donations and clean/repair gently used ones

United Methodist Women

Creates a fellowship of women who support one another while contributing to local and global women's, youth and children's missions

How to serve – join a UMW circle; help with making candy and cheeseball at specified times for fundraisers

Volunteers in Mission

Build homes for people in need of affordable housing in Harford and Cecil counties for Habitat for Humanity; attend short-term domestic mission trips, typically after a flood or hurricane, to help with local clean-up and building repair/construction and help those in need

How to serve - Volunteer to work on a home construction; supply lunches for workers; attend fundraising events

Welcome One Emergency Homeless Shelter

Prepares and serves meals to residents at the Welcome One homeless shelter in Belcamp

Adult Discipleship

Provides Bible-based adult Christian education that fosters a relationship with Christ and spiritual growth

How to serve - Participate in a class; lead/host a new small group or class; volunteer in any of the church's ministries or missions; invite friends to church activities

Children's Ministries

C4 Kids Sunday School

Create environments to engage and teach children nursery through 5th grade to love God and others with all their Compassion (heart), Creativity (soul), Curiosity (mind), and Courage (strength)

How to serve - Volunteer to teach a Sunday school class; assist in the nursery

Vacation Bible School

Reaches out to the community through fellowship and teaching so children 3 years – 5th grade can be exposed to, or reminded of, how much God loves

How to serve – Invite a child to VBS; volunteer as a crew leader or teacher

Young Adult Ministry

Provides a faith-forming context for young adults (18 yrs - 30 yrs) to work through relationships, marriage, college, work, etc through Bible study, service and social activities

Youth Ministries

How to serve – Teach; mentor; chaperone; donate supplies for mission trips and retreats

AMPed

Provides basic biblical knowledge to youth 6th-8th grades on Sunday mornings

Baltimore Mission

Provides an opportunity for youth to serve children in Baltimore City by running a 1-week Vacation Bible School at the Agape House in July

Baltimore Saturday School Ministry

Provides basic biblical knowledge in inner city youth to develop a relationship with Jesus; involves our youth in service

Confirmation

Confirms youth in 8th-12th grades in the United Methodist Church as they develop and strengthen their relationship with Jesus; connects youth with BAUMC

How to serve - Attend a meeting in September for the upcoming year's program;

Middle High Youth

Provides the foundation of Biblical education in a fun and engaging way through the use of interactive Bible studies for youth 6th -8th grade in a weekly gathering

Senior High Youth

Provides the foundation of Biblical education in a fun and engaging way through the use of interactive Bible studies for youth in 9th – 12th grade in a weekly gathering

Rock Retreat

Spends a weekend in Ocean City with the Methodist sponsored retreat ROCK
