- ❖ **Coming to Colonial Heights:**
 - Harbor Freight – Former HHGregg Store opening sometime mid-May
 - Sedona Taphouse
 - Longhorn Steakhouse – Former Lonestar Restaurant anticipated to open Spring 2018

- ❖ **Temple Avenue Signal Coordination** – A future federal-aid project is planned to modernize and interconnect traffic signals on Temple Avenue with preliminary engineering planned to start in February 2018. While the final project scoping is not complete, staff will plan to include a signalized crosswalk on Temple Avenue at the intersection with Southpark Boulevard with construction planned to begin in 2019.

- ❖ **Citizens Government Academy**
 - The City of Colonial Heights Citizens Government Academy, a free 8-week program, provides residents with an opportunity to learn more about the operations and services of their City government. Each week, program participants visit different departments to meet the director or elected official and learn about specific departmental operations through hands-on activities, demonstrations, group discussions and site tours.
 - Academy programs are held during the spring (March-May) on Thursdays from 6-8 p.m. at various facilities throughout the City. Applicants must be 18 years-of-age or older, a resident of the City of Colonial Heights, attend at least 7 out of 8 sessions and participate in the graduation ceremony. Class size is limited.

- ❖ **Fort Clifton Festival** – The annual Fort Clifton Festival will be held at Fort Clifton Park on May 12 & 13, 2018 from 10:30 a.m. - 5:30 p.m. The festival is family-oriented and educational, portraying the historic significance of the fort and its importance in the Civil War to the Petersburg defense line. Arts and crafts persons sell a variety of hand made items. Civil War relic exhibits are on display, along with re-enactors and demonstrations. Children's rides and concessions are available each day of the festival. Local civic groups sell hot dogs, sausage and peppers, hamburgers, funnel cakes, pizza, barbecue, french fries, ice cream, baked goods, and more. Door prizes and raffles will be held each day.
- ❖ **The Great American Backyard Campout** – This event will take place June 22-24, 2018 at Fort Clifton Park. Join the Recreation and Parks Department for this overnight camping event in Historic Fort Clifton Park on the Appomattox River, whether you're a first-timer or an old hand, for traditional outdoor and camping activities such as storytelling, s'mores, crafts, games, night hikes, river exploration, and, of course, camping in tents.
