

LAY EUCHARISTIC (LEV) MINISTRY

A Eucharistic Visitor is a lay person authorized to take the Consecrated Elements in a timely manner following a Celebration of Holy Eucharist to members of the congregation who, by reason of illness or infirmity, were unable to be present at the Celebration.

The Congregational Care Commission provides training for LEVs, usually an hour in length. Later they are taken out two times with another LEV to witness the visit in action. You do not have to be a Chalice or have had any other experience. You do need a desire to help others and a willing heart. You can select the Sunday best suited for your schedule and you will always be given a recipient who would like very much for you to visit them.
