COOKING CLASS -AUGUST 25TH 2017**

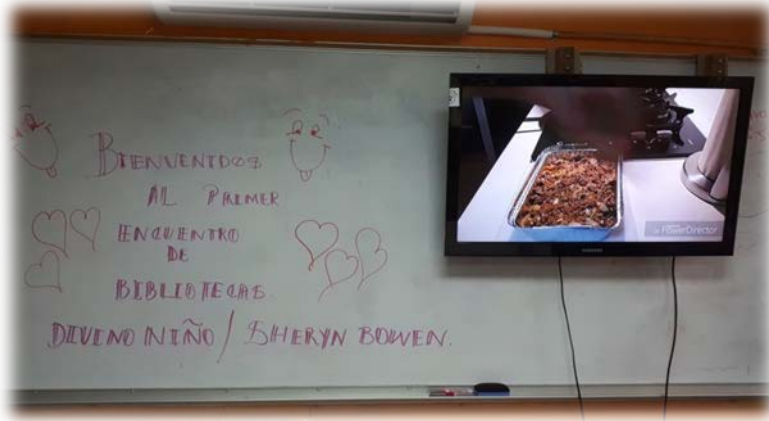


BANANA LASAGNA
