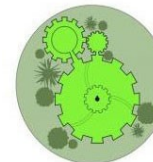

The Gulcz Sister City relationship is managed by the Polish Heritage Awareness Society, a non-profit organization, "dedicated to the education, promotion and preservation of Polish American Heritage." Some activities include hosting family-to-family visits in Gulcz and Stevens Point and providing computers and school supplies to Gulcz.
