As the little boy told his teacher, "I may be sitting on the outside, but I'm standing on the inside." His body was demonstrating obedience while his soul was in a state of rebellion. It's tempting to equate conformity with conversion. Your child's conduct never embarrasses you. You are proud of how well your child behaves and exhibits respect to everyone in authority. He or she must be a child of God! But we know better. The greatest evidence that we are redeemed is not the extent of our obedience but our extreme love for God, His Son Jesus and His Word. We obey God's rules not despite our desires but because of our desires. We don't study and memorize God's Word only to get some insights for living, but because we exceedingly love the Author. Know your heart. Know your child's heart.
