### Devotional Thought:

2 Timothy 2:15 presents a challenge that recognizes the benefit of a growth mindset: “Do your best to present yourself to God as one approved, a worker who has no need to be ashamed, rightly handling the word of truth.” Paul’s command is to “do your best to ...” Notice that he does not say, “be perfect.” The phrase “do your best to” acknowledges that as people we are not perfect and that we will make mistakes. It is also a call for growth and development because our best effort today will not be our best effort tomorrow when we have grown in knowledge and skill.

Notice how this verse ends: “rightly handling the word of truth.” We can only “do our best” at “rightly handling the word of truth” when we are daily immersed in the word of truth. Reading our Bible each day is one way that we can Love God with all our mind.
