In Romans 13:8-10, Paul is writing regarding Old Testament law, specifically the Ten Commandments. He reminds his readers of the commandments the Israelites had to live by. Specifically, he references the laws about not murdering, stealing, coveting, or committing adultery. Paul does an excellent job of giving us a tangible display of how Christ came to fulfill the law. There are movements to abandon Old Testament law, but it provides a standard for us and shows us what Christ came to fulfill. Paul provides us with an answer that can be applied to life: love your neighbor. By fulfilling the new law of loving one another as Christ has loved us, we too can fulfill the law. Loving your neighbor as yourself, seeking the better welfare of others before our own, provides us with an opportunity to share Christ's love through our actions.
